

Mauro Pinciaroli



Mauro Pinciaroli was born in Milan in 1988. He began his studies very young and graduated in classical guitar with the highest honor at the Conservatory Giuseppe Verdi in Milan. He proceeded to further his studies at the Accademia Chigiana in Siena with Oscar Ghiglia, at the prestigious "Academy F. Tarrega" in Pordenone, with Paolo Pegoraro, with whom he has also graduated with the highest honor at the "Universtät für Musik und darstellende Kunst" in Graz, Austria. Since 2008, Mauro has focused principally on early music played on historical instruments including lute, archlute, theorbo, baroque and romantic guitar. He successfully concluded the bachelor degree in lute at the Conservatory of Milan and continued his master degree studies at the University of Vienna with Luciano Contini. He specialized in *basso continuo* attending masterclasses with Luca Pianca and Giangiacomo Pinardi. Mr. Pinciaroli started an intense career as a chamber musician in early music ensemble and orchestras playing at the European major concert halls. He is the official lute player of Coin du Roi orchestra (Milan), Vox Orchester

(Frankfurt), Collegium Musicum Riga (Latvia). Along with several radio and television participations (RSI Lugano, Latvia TV), he has recorded two monographs of the Italian composers Pietro Antonio Locatelli and Antonio Caldara.
